### MEETING CALLED TO ORDER – Phil LaPierre

- Salute to the Flag.

### SECRETARY – ALLEN WARD

- Previous meeting minutes were emailed to members with no additions or corrections
- Motion to approve was made by: Len Adair seconded by: Marshall Pugh motion approved.

### PRESIDENTS REPORT – Phil LaPierre

- Course is in poor shape and hopefully holes 2&3 will be back too par 4's on Thursday.
- # 12 will be temporary for some time.

### VICE PRESIDENT – Carlos Monroy

- We have 2 members with a hole in one. On 12/10/25 Mark Mckinney on hole #7, and 12/21/25 Brian Ortega on hole #2, each will receive a trophy and \$50.00.
- We have started preparations this week for the president's cup luncheon which will be held on 3/12/26. We're waiting to see how the restaurant handles the upcoming Guys and Dolls luncheon; if it goes well, we'll consider using them in the future. We are also looking for sponsors for extra gifts to be raffled off.

### TRESURES REPORT – BARRIE SMITH

- P&L YTD comparison dated December 2025 was discussed.
- Bank balance is \$11,524.00.
- Financial statement will be posted on web site thetpmc.com on Friday 1/9/26.
  - Phil added to Berrie's report that our major expenses will be coming up.
  - SCGA bill and President's Cup Luncheon.

### TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR – MIKE STAUF AND ASSITANT MARK BENNET

- Again, some of scores posted on the board were incorrect. Mike had posted results and ran the certs, and then he received calls stating that their score was incorrect. Mike had to check every score card. This adds considerable time.
- We have asked you to post your own net score each week or at least verify that the score posted is correct.
- The board has made a ruling that if a score card is incomplete or incorrect the team will be DQ from tournament play, you must initial your score on the card.
- There is a ruling from SCGA that if you sign an incorrect score card you are DQ.

#### **MEMBERSHIP DIRECTOR – RICHARD WACHAL**

- We have 120 paid members this year compared to 140 last year.
- 19 members with GHIN numbers have not paid; they will be dropped if no payment arrangements are made. Of these, 10 are from the par-3 group, possibly due to Century Course's closure and them not wanting to play the millennium course.
- There are 14 new members replacing ones that have left us.

#### **HANDICAP DIRECTOR – MIKE MORRISSEY**

- Currently, we want you to post to the alternate course on GHIN.
- For shortened holes, post par plus your handicap for that hole.

Jonathan from Western Golf visited to share updates and answer questions. He announced an upcoming Guys and Dolls tournament open to everyone. Course maintenance includes cleaning up, drying, and building berms on holes 12 and 18. Temporary tee boxes will be set up on holes 2 and 3 due to muddy conditions, with a new red tee box on hole 3. Hole 18 will be recircled, and work is underway to open the ditch behind holes 9–12 to improve water flow.

#### **GREENS DIRECTOR – BOB BARBON not present**

- Report by Allen Ward from RRF meeting
- Jonathan Benrod reported that they're building temporary tee boxes on holes 3, 10, and 15 for the red Tees.
- He had bought a new water pump for the pond 16 but it hadn't been installed.
- He was expecting the century course to be opened around Christmas, but it would be cart path only. The Par 3 Ladies Group has recommended postponing until after the beginning of the year, which will allow the course additional time to firm up.
- At this time, there is no projection or commitment regarding when 12 or 18 holes will reopen.

#### **SPECIAL EVENTS – CLEVE SCHWENKE AND STEVE SAUNDERS**

- Our next special event will be January 22nd, and it will be a 4-man, 2 best ball, entry fee will be \$10 per player.

#### **RULES DIRECTOR – RAY CASTAGNER**

- There seems to be some confusion about when the ball moves, with wind or bumping it as to penalty stroke or not. I will verify the rules and post them in the caddy shack and in the fairway finders.
- With temporary greens once you're inside the painted circle just putt once, and if you missed, then up your ball and count as second putt.

**PAR-3 DIRECTOR – BOB GRUNDY** not present

- Don Morgan filling in for Bob.
- As of now we only have four players signed up for next Thursday's play.
- Reminding everybody that the century course is a tough little course and we invite any of you that would like to play to come and join us.

**GUY'S AND DOLL'S – MARSHALL PUGH**

- We have 132 players signed up to play.
- We tried to set teams with low, mid, and hi handicappers but it became difficult as many did not write down their handicap.
- We will be handicapping the teams; low handicap men play from the blue tees.
- We are having KP hole for men and women and adding a long drive hole.
- The charge of \$25 per player.
  - \$15.00 for restaurant to cater the lunch and \$10.00 for prize money.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- Allen Ward reminded club members who haven't voted on the HOA issues to submit their ballots by the extended deadline of 1/15/26.

Pat Ream was appointed nominating chairman, at our next meeting February 2nd, he will introduce those members that have been nominated to run for next year's board.
