The end of November was un-expected. While rain is often welcomed in the desert, it inevitably creates a mess and additional cleanup work for our maintenance teams across both golf courses. To assist with ongoing cleanup efforts, management has hired an outside crew who will continue working on both courses. This team will be helping create a berm system to better control water flow during future storms.

Tournament News

This month's special events include:

RESCHEDULED Opening Season Super Scramble:

The season opening tournament was canceled due to rain damage to the course. The tournament has been re-scheduled; I spoke with Jonathon on Nov 19, and he talked about rescheduling the tournament to Dec 5th. Meet in the rear parking lot at 8:00am, shotgun start at 8:30am.

CANCELED Red, White & Gold Tournament: Thursday, November 20, 2025, 7:00 AM & 12

This tournament was canceled due to rain damage to the course. The tournament is TBD and there is no new tournament date.

Quota Tournament: Thursday, December 18, 2025, 7:00 AM & 12 PM

The Goal - Each golfer tries to reach or beat their own “quota” (a target number of points) based on their handicap. Points are earned by how well you score on each hole.

1. Setting Your Quota

- Start with 36 points.
- Subtract your course handicap.
- Example: A 10-handicap golfer’s quota is 26 points ($36 - 10 = 26$).

2. Scoring Points

Points are based on strokes taken relative to par:

- Bogey = 1 point
- Par = 2 points
- Birdie = 4 points
- Eagle = 8 points
- Double Bogey or worse = 0 points

3. How to Play

Play your round as usual, using your assigned tees. On each hole, convert your score to points using the system above. Add your points throughout the round. When you have finished your round, compare your total points earned to your quota.

4. Determining Winners

The winner is the golfer who scores the most points over quota. Example: If your quota is 26 and you score 30, you are +4. The field is ranked by “plus” or “minus” points against quota.

5. Tiebreakers

Ties are broken by best back 9, then best back 6, then best back 3, and finally hole-by-hole starting with #18.



Club Updates

The maintenance staff has been working overtime to repair the rain damage to the Millennium course, especially holes 2, 12, 15, and 18. We applaud their effort in restoring the course for play.
